

At a Regular Meeting of the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, held in the City Hall May 7, 1926, the following Local Law was introduced:

By Alderman Agnew, seconded by Alderman Marsh.

LOCAL LAW NO. 1 of 1926.

A local law in relation to powers of the Common Council to increase the compensation of officers and employees and of any office or position of the City.

BE IT ENACTED by the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, as follows:

Sec. 1. The Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh shall have the power by resolution to increase at any time the compensation of officers and employees of any office or position of said City and order the payment of the same out of the treasury of the City. Such increased compensation may be made after such salary or compensation shall have been fixed and provided for in the budget of the City for the fiscal year.

Sec. 2. Every provision of the existing charter or local laws of the City of Plattsburgh and of Chapter six hundred four of the Laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-three inconsistent herewith is hereby superseded.

Sec. 3. This local law shall take effect immediately.
