

LOCAL LAW No. 2 of 1926.

A Local Law superseding Section 80 of the Charter of the City of Plattsburgh, providing for the appointment and salary of the members of the Police Force.


BE IT ENACTED by the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, as follows:

Section 1. The permanent police force of the City of Plattsburgh shall consist of a Chief of Police and Patrolmen who shall be appointed by the Mayor subject to the approval of the Common Council. The Mayor may appoint special policemen as he may deem it necessary. The Mayor may, with the approval of the Common Council, dispense with the services of the Chief of Police and may designate one of the Patrolmen to be Acting Chief of Police, who shall receive Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) per month in addition to his salary as Patrolman while so acting.

Section 2. Section 80 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902, and any acts amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto, and any other provisions of the Charter of the City of Plattsburgh inconsistent herewith are hereby superseded.

Section 3. This Local Law shall take effect January 1, 1927.
