

Regular Meeting of the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, held April 18, 1947.

PRESENT: Aldermen Gervais, LeClair, Gioiosa, Demary, Ryan and Cardi.

LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF 1947.

ENTITLED AN ACT creating the position of RECREATION DIRECTOR for duty under the CITY OF PLATTSBURGH YOUTH COMMISSION, prescribing the duties of such position and providing for the classification and compensation therefor.

BE IT ENACTED by the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, as follows:

SECTION 1. Creation and Classification. There shall be employed by the Plattsburgh Youth Commission of the City of Plattsburgh, New York a Recreation Director which position shall be classified in the Municipal Civil Service Commission of the City of Plattsburgh, New York in accordance with the following schedule:

<u>Class Title.</u>	<u>Jurisdictional Title.</u>
Recreation Director	Competitive

SECTION 2. Duties. Has charge of the administration of the City Recreation Program; promotes the organization of recreation activities in order to secure maximum use of playgrounds, gymnasiums, and parks; arranges for the use of school buildings, picnic areas, playgrounds, and parks for recreation activities; plans and organizes softball, basketball, and other competitive sports leagues; conducts training courses for playground supervisors; purchases supplies and equipment, and prepares departmental budgets; prepares periodic reports for Youth Commission; advises Youth Commission on budgetary requirements.


SECTION 3. Maximum and minimum compensation and rate of increase. The holder of the position created by Section 1 of this Act shall be compensated as follows: Column 1 the minimum compensation or entrance salary; Column 2 the maximum compensation and Column 3 shows the rate of yearly increase until the maximum is reached.

<u>Column 1.</u>	<u>Column 2.</u>	<u>Column 3.</u>
\$3,000.00	\$3,500.00	\$250.00

SECTION 4. Time of taking effect. This Local Law shall take effect immediately after public hearing has been held thereon and approval by the Mayor.

On roll call Aldermen Gervais, LeClair, Gioiosa, Demary, Ryan and Cardi voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative.
