LOCAL LAW NO. 3 OF 1977

ENTITLED AN ACT CREATING THE POSITION OF PRINCIPAL
STENOGRAPHER IN THE MUNICIPAL LIGHTING DEPARTMENT
OF THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH, NEW YORK, IN THE
COMPETITIVE CLASS OF THE MUNICIPAL CIVIL SERVICE,
PROVIDING THE MANNER OF APPOINTMENT AND PROVIDING
FOR THE METHOD OF ESTABLISHING THE SALARY AND TERMS
AND CONDITIONS OF SAID POSITION.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the
City of Plattsburgh, New York:

SECTION 1. CREATION OF POSITION

There shall be in the Municipal Lighting Department
of the City of Plattsburgh, a principal stenographer, which position
shall be in the competitive class of the Municipal Civil Service.

SECTION 2. APPOINTMENT

The principal stenographer shall be appointed by
the Mayor subject to confirmation by the Common Council. The
concurrence of three (3) Aldermen shall be deemed a confirmation.

SECTION 3. SALARY

The salary of the principal stenographer and the
terms and conditions of employment shall be fixed from time to
time by resolution of the Mayor and Common Council.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE

This act shall take effect immediately after public hearing and approval by the Mayor.
