Aubrey Eldridge: commented on a question posed last week by a panel member, "why are we giving agendas" (to the public); concerned about rules and public transparency.

Camden Ellis: pointed out the similarities and differences between our panel work and the Governor's Executive Order; wondering why the Executive Order states the deadline of April 2021, while the Resolution says the deadline is December 2020; wants the timeline extended to April 2021.

Sarah Martin: pointed out that the Council Resolution may contain demographics that are not included; 3 months difference is alarming; she noticed someone dropped out; she had a budgetary question on re-allocating the budget and suggested 'defunding the police' and put money towards mental health needs of the community instead.

Sean Harrigan: discussed his own addiction struggles; suggested police reform should include how police interact with addicts; addicts should feel safe in their community; discusses the Good Samaritan Law.
