**3. AGENDA ITEMS BROUGHT FORWARD FROM DEPARTMENTS TO BE APPROVED BY COMMITTEE AND RECOMMENDED TO COUNCIL:**

- 1. Request from STOP Domestic Violence/BHSN to hang a display on the railings located around Macdonough monument for the month of October for Domestic Violence Awareness Month. STOP Domestic Violence/BHSN will be responsible for installing and removing the display, all debris and understand that the city is not responsible for any loss or damage
- 2. Whereas, § 233-2 of the City Code of the City of Plattsburgh states as follows: Sidewalk and curb required. Each parcel of property that is contiguous to a public street or highway shall have a sidewalk and curb along that portion of the property which abuts on a public street, alley or highway, except where there is evidence that such sidewalk or curbs is not required for the safety and convenience of the public as determined by the Common Council; and

Whereas, Councilor Armstrong, acting solely on behalf of a constituent residing in her ward, has forwarded a request for a Council resolution to not install new sidewalks on the West side of Maine Road for at least five years and to not replace, modify or expand the existing 4' sidewalks located on the east side of Maine Road.

Now, therefore, it is hereby resolved, in accordance with the request therefore, that the Common Council has determined that the portion of the current construction project which is limited to the installation of sidewalks on the West side of Maine Road--be discontinued as that sidewalk to be installed on the West side of Maine Road will not be necessary for the safety and convenience of the public; and it is further

Resolved, that the portion of the current construction project which is limited to the reconstruction and expansion of the 4' sidewalks located on the East side of Maine Road be discontinued.

- 3. Request from Environmental Manager Jon Ruff that Janelle Henry's salary, in her title as Water Resource Chemist Level 3 Manager, shall be at Range 8, Step 9 for a base salary of \$69,045, effective the next bi-weekly pay period.
