

Regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, held February 18, 1938.

LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF 1938.

ENTITLED AN ACT TO AMEND Section 11 of the Charter of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, entitled "An Act To Incorporate The City Of Plattsburgh, New York" as amended by Local Law No. 2 of 1924; Local Law No. 1 of 1925, Local Law No. 4 of 1925, Local Law No. 5 of 1925, Local Law No. 2 of 1927, and Local Law No. 3 of 1934, and as herein amended, to provide additional compensation for special or extra services to be rendered or performed by the Corporation Counsel.


BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, that Section 11 of the Charter of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as amended by Local Law No. 2 of 1924, Local Law No. 1 of 1925, Local Law No. 4 of 1925, Local Law No. 5 of 1925, Local Law No. 2 of 1927, and Local Law No. 3 of 1934, be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

Section 1. The Corporation Counsel may, however, for the conduct, argument, prosecution, or defense, of important litigation, cases or proceedings, in which the City is an interested party, receive such additional compensation as in the opinion of the Common Council will reasonably compensate him for the special or extra services rendered or to be performed in behalf of the City, in the prosecution or defense of such important, difficult or unusual proceedings, which extra compensation shall be in addition to the fixed salary of the Corporation Counsel, and payment of such additional compensation as may be authorized by the Common Council may be made from any special funds or unestimated receipts unappropriated which are available for such purpose.


This Local Law shall become effective after Public Hearing and approval by the Mayor.
