

At a Regular Meeting of the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, held on the 5th day of October, 1951.

PRESENT: Mayor Tyrell, Aldermen Holland, LeClair, Villoni, Demary, and Slattery.

ABSENT: Alderman Cardi.

By Alderman Holland; seconded by Alderman Demary:

LOCAL LAW NO. 4 of 1951

ENTITLED AN ACT amending Local Law No. 8 of 1950 providing for the minimum and maximum compensation, rate of increase and time of taking effect of such increase for city officials and creating, continuing, classifying and providing for compensation, rate of increase and time of taking effect of such increase, for the various employees of the City of Plattsburgh and in this instance establishing the position of Senior Clerk in the Department of Health and providing for the pay for dentists when employed.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Local Law No. 8 of 1950 is hereby amended so that the provisions relating to the Department of Health shall read as follows:

The dentists shall receive \$5.00 per hour or \$15.00 for a 3-hr. clinic, when employed.


SECTION 2. Time of Taking Effect. This act shall take effect after public hearing and approval by the Mayor.
