LOCAL LAW NO. 7 OF 1954

ENTITLED A LOCAL LAW AMENDING SECTION 1 OF LOCAL LAW NO. 5 OF 1954, IN THIS INSTANCE PROVIDING THAT THE REFERENDUM SPECIFIED BE HELD AT THE NEXT GENERAL ELECTION ON NOVEMBER 2nd, 1954.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, as follows:

Section 1..Section 1 of Local Law No. 5 of 1954 is amended to read as follows:


Section 1. Referendum. There shall be submitted to the electors of the City of Plattsburgh at the next general election, November 2, 1954, the following question,

"Shall there be a commission to draft a new City Charter?"

Section 2. This act shall take effect after Public Hearing and approval by the Mayor.

On roll call, Aldermen Holland, Chasolen, Villoni, Laravia, Arbenger and Brewster voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative, CARRIED.
