

Regular Meeting of the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, held March 14, 1947.

PRESENT: Mayor Tyrell, Aldermen Gervais, Gioiosa, Demary, Ryan and Cardi.

ABSENT: Alderman O'Connell.

LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF 1947.

ENTITLED AN ACT to amend Section 11, Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902, as amended by various local laws to date, in this instance providing for the minimum and maximum compensation, rate of increase and time of taking effect of such increases, for the city officials of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, and adding Section 11-B to the Charter of the City of Plattsburgh, providing for the minimum and maximum compensation for employees of said city and fixing the time of taking effect.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 11 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902 as amended to date, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 11. Compensation of City Officials.

The members of the Municipal Airport Commission, members of the Board of Health, members of the Board of Education, except the Clerk, members of the Planning Board, members of the Park and Beach Commission, and members of the Plumbing Board shall receive no compensation for their services.

The salary of the Mayor shall be \$2100.00 per year, \$1200.00 of which shall be payable out of the General Fund and \$900.00 of which shall be payable out of the Water Fund.

The salary of each Alderman shall be \$10.00 for each meeting of the Common Council actually attended, but not to exceed the sum of \$500.00 per year, payable out of the General Fund.

The salary of the City Judge shall be \$2200.00 per year, which shall be payable out of the Police Fund.

The salary of the Clerk of the City Court shall be \$1800.00 per year, which shall be payable out of the Police Fund.

The salary of the Acting City Judge shall be \$5.00 for each day that he sits, not to exceed the sum of \$300.00 in any one year, also payable out of the Police Fund.

The salary of the Chief of Police or the Acting Chief of Police shall be \$3,000.00 per year, payable out of the Police Fund.

The salary of the Police Sergeants shall be \$2500.00 per year upon appointment, which shall be payable out of the Police Fund.

The salary of each regular Patrolman shall be as follows:

\$2,000.00 for the first year of service,
\$2,100.00 for the second year of service,
\$2,300.00 for the third year and each
succeeding year thereafter,

which shall be payable out of the Police Fund.

The salary of the Fire Chief shall be \$2,650.00 per year, which shall be payable out of the Fire Fund.

The salary of the Assistant Fire Chief shall be \$2,500.00 per year, which shall be payable out of the Fire Fund.

The salary of the regular Firemen shall be as follows:

\$2,000.00 for the first year of service,
\$2,100.00 for the second year of service,
\$2,300.00 for the third year of service, and
each succeeding year thereafter,

which shall be payable out of the Fire Fund.

The salary of the Municipal Civil Service Commissioners shall be \$660.00 per year, which shall be payable out of the General Fund.

The salary of the Public Health Officer shall be \$1,650.00 per year, which shall be payable out of the Board of Health Fund.

The salary of each member of the Board of Assessors shall be \$330.00 per year, except the Chairman of the Board of Assessors, which shall be \$440.00 per year, which shall be payable out of the General Fund.

The salary of the Corporation Counsel shall be \$2,300.00 per year, \$950.00 of which shall be payable out of the General Fund, \$900.00 payable out of the Water Fund, \$300.00 payable out of the Sewer Operation and Maintenance Fund and \$150.00 payable out of the Municipal Lighting Department Revenues.

The salary of the Sealer of Weights and Measures shall be \$385.00 per year, which shall be payable out of the General Fund.

The salary of the Superintendent of Public Works shall be \$4,500.00 per year, which sum shall be payable as follows: \$1,925.00 out of the Street and Sewer Fund, \$1,925.00 payable out of the Water Fund, \$150.00 payable from the Municipal Lighting Department Revenues, and \$500.00 payable from the Municipal Airport Fund.

The salary of the City Chamberlain, upon appointment, shall be \$2,500.00 per year; the same shall be increased annually at the rate of \$100.00 per year, until the maximum salary of \$3,000.00 is reached, provided, however, that the present incumbent in the Office of the City Chamberlain shall receive the maximum compensation of \$3,000.00 per year, said salary to be paid as follows: 40% payable out of the General Fund, 40% payable out of the Water Fund, 12% payable out of the Municipal Lighting Department Revenues and 8% payable out of the Sewer Maintenance and Operation Fund.

The salary of the City Clerk, upon appointment, shall be \$3,400.00 per year, the same to be increased at the rate of \$100.00 per year until the maximum salary of \$4,000.00 is reached, provided, however, that the present incumbent in the Office of the City Clerk shall receive the maximum compensation of \$4,000.00 per year payable as follows: 40% payable out of the General Fund, 40% payable out of the Water Fund, 12% payable out of the Municipal Lighting Department Revenues, and 8% payable out of the Sewer Operations and Maintenance Revenues.

The salary of the Deputy City Clerk, upon appointment, shall be \$2,400.00 per year, and the same shall be increased annually at the rate of \$100.00 per year, until the maximum salary of \$2,600.00 is reached, the same to be payable as follows: 40% payable out of the General Fund, 40% payable out of the Water Fund, 12% payable out of the Municipal Lighting Department Revenues, and 8% payable out of the Sewer Operations and Maintenance Fund.

Supervisors and Constables shall be entitled to receive the same compensation for their services as corresponding officers in the Towns are entitled to receive for like services.

Inspectors of Election and such other Election Officers as are entitled to be appointed, shall receive compensation which is hereby fixed as follows: Primary Day, \$7.00, each Registration Day, \$7.00, and for General Election Day, \$13.00, all of which shall be payable out of the General Fund.

The salary of the Building Inspector, upon appointment, shall be \$2,200.00 per year, the same to be increased at the rate of \$100.00 per year, until a \$2,500.00 maximum is reached.

SECTION 2. Section 11-B of the City Charter is hereby amended to read as follows:

"There shall be in the various departments listed below, the following positions which are classified in the Municipal Civil Service of the City of Plattsburgh and the occupants of which shall receive compensation, in accordance with these Schedules: Column 1 shows the minimum or entrance compensation, Column 2 shows the maximum compensation which may be received, and Column 3 shows the rate of yearly increase until the maximum compensation in Column 2 is reached:

(Provided, however, that notwithstanding the foregoing schedule, the present Filtration Plant Operator shall receive the maximum salary of \$3300.00 per year.)

In the Department of Public Works, skilled laborers shall receive the sum of 95¢ per hour, semi-skilled laborers shall receive the sum of 90¢ per hour, and common laborers shall receive the sum of 85¢ per hour.

In the Fire Department, Call Firemen shall be paid at the rate of \$110.00 per year.

In the Health Department, the Dentist shall receive \$11.00 per clinic, when employed.

The salary of the Plumbing Inspector shall be \$600.00 per year upon appointment, payable out of the General Fund.

SECTION 3. PART-TIME EMPLOYMENT.

The Common Council may employ persons on a part-time basis to perform any of the duties of the positions listed in Section 2 of this Local Law, as herein modified as it relates to Section 11-B of the City Charter.

SECTION 4. LAWS REPEALED.


Local Law No. 1 of 1945 and Local Law No. 1 of 1946 are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. TIME OF TAKING EFFECT.


This Act shall become effective April 1st, 1947, and after Public Hearing and upon approval by the Mayor.
