LOCAL LAW NO. 18 OF 1948

ENTITLED AN ACT amending Local Law No. 1 of 1940 and Local Law  
No. 1 of 1941 and in this instance prescribing additional duties for  
the building inspector and fixing the salary thereof.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and the Common Council of the City  
of Plattsburgh, New York, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Local Law No. 1 of 1940 as amended by Local  
Law No. 1 of 1941 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to appoint a building  
inspector under open competitive Civil Service Examination for which  
the following salary is hereby fixed: \$3200.00 per annum upon appoint-  
ment, with an annual increase of \$100 per year until the maximum  
salary of \$3500.00 is reached.


SECTION 2. Section 2 of Local Law No. 1 of 1940 is hereby amended  
as follows: By adding thereto to said section No. 2 the following  
sentence: " That in addition to all other duties as hereinbefore  
specified the Building Inspector shall act as Clerk of the Commission  
of Assessments and Taxation of the City of Plattsburgh ".

SECTION 3. Laws Repealed. Section 145 A of the City Charter of  
the City of Plattsburgh insofar as it relates to the Clerk of the  
Commission of Assessments and Taxation is hereby superseded.


SECTION 4. Time of Taking Effect. This act shall take effect  
as of January 1, 1949 after public hearing and approval of the Mayor.
