

Regular Meeting of the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, held November 15, 1946.

PRESENT: Mayor Tyrell, Aldermen Gervais, Gioiosa, Demary and Ryan.

By Alderman Demary; seconded by Alderman Ryan:

LOCAL LAW NO. 4 OF 1946.

ENTITLED AN ACT to amend Section 11, Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902, as last amended by Local Law No. 1 of 1946, in this instance providing for the compensation of inspectors of election and other election officers, and for the time of taking effect of such compensation.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as follows:

Sec. 1. Section 11 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902, as last amended by Local Law No. 1 of 1946, paragraph 24 thereof, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Inspectors of Election and such other election officers as may be entitled to be appointed, shall receive compensation which is hereby fixed as follows:

all of which shall be payable out of the General Fund."


Sec. 2. This compensation shall be effective as of January 1st, 1946, after public hearing and approval by the Mayor.

On roll call, Aldermen Gervais, Gioiosa, Demary and Ryan voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative, (Aldermen O'Connell and Cardi being absent);
