LOCAL LAW NO. 4 OF 1982

AN ACT AMENDING PARAGRAPH 2 OF TITLE II, SECTION 9 OF CHAPTER 269 OF THE LAWS OF 1902 TO PROVIDE THAT THE TERMS OF OFFICE OF THE MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH SHALL BE FOUR (4) YEARS

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as follows:

SECTION 1: Paragraph 2 of Section 9 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902 is amended to read as follows:

2. Terms of Elective Officers. The term of office of the Mayor shall be four (4) years. The term of office of Aldermen shall be four (4) years. The term of office of legislators shall be in duration the same as legislators in Towns of Clinton County.

SECTION 2: All other provisions and special acts or local laws including Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902 known as the City Charter as amended by various local laws inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby superseded.

SECTION 3: This act shall be effective as to officers elected at the general election held in the month of November, 1983, for terms of office commencing January 1, 1984.

On roll call, Aldermen Stewart, Stanley, Blumette, Lombardoni and Griffin voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative; CARRIED
